

**CALL FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION**  
**CITY OF SMYRNA**

NOTICE is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2017, to fill a vacancy in the office of **Smyrna City Council, Ward 3**, caused by the resignation of Ms. Teri Anulewicz. If necessary, a Special Election Runoff will be held on December 5, 2017. The poll will be open from 7:00am to 7:00pm and the election will be held in the following election precinct:

- SMYRNA 3A - Smyrna Community Center, 200 Village Green Cir., Smyrna, GA 30080

**Qualifying** for candidates will be held in the Human Resources Room at the Smyrna City Hall, 2800 King St., Smyrna GA, beginning Monday, September 18, 2017 at 8:30 and ending on Wednesday September 20, 2017 at noon. The hours for qualifying shall be Monday and Tuesday from 8:30am until 4:30pm and closed for lunch each day from 12noon to 1pm, and Wednesday from 8:30am until 12:00noon. The qualifying fee shall be \$567 to be paid by cash, personal check, money order, or cashier's check made out to the City of Smyrna. Each candidate must meet the qualifications for office as prescribed by State Law and Municipal Code. Each candidate or his or her designee shall file a Notice of Candidacy and Affidavit, such form is available at [www.sos.ga.gov](http://www.sos.ga.gov) and will also be provided at the qualifying location.

**Residents of Ward 3** who are qualified to register to vote, and are not currently registered, or who may need to update their voter registration information, may do so through the close of business Tuesday, October 10, 2017. Persons may register to vote online at [www.mvp.sos.ga.gov](http://www.mvp.sos.ga.gov) or at any of the designated places for registering Cobb County residents.

**Early In-Person Voting** will begin Monday, October 16, 2017 and end on Friday, November 3, 2017. The hours and locations for Early Voting will be available on [www.CobbElections.org](http://www.CobbElections.org).

**Voters who wish to vote by Mail** may apply by submitting an application to the Cobb County Elections Office at P.O. Box 649, Marietta, GA 30061 or by faxing an application to (770) 528-2458. Applications will be available at [www.CobbElections.org](http://www.CobbElections.org). Voted ballots must be received by 7:00pm, Tuesday, November 7, 2017.
