

CALL FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION

NOTICE is hereby given that a Special Election will be held on TUESDAY, MAY 22, 2018, in conjunction with the General Primary, to fill a vacancy in the office of **Kennesaw City Council, Post 2**, caused by the resignation of Ms. Yvette M. A. Daniel. The polls will be open from 7:00am to 7:00pm and the election will be held in the following election precincts:

Qualifying for candidates will be held in the Training Room at the Kennesaw City Hall, 2529 J.O. Stephenson Ave., Kennesaw, GA 30144, beginning Monday, March 5, 2018 at 8:30am and ending on Wednesday March 7, 2018 at 12:30pm. The hours for qualifying shall be Monday and Tuesday from 8:30am until 4:30pm and closed for lunch each day from 12noon to 1pm, and Wednesday from 8:30am until 12:30pm. The qualifying fee shall be \$360 to be paid by cash, personal check, money order, or cashier's check made out to the City of Kennesaw. Each candidate must meet the qualifications for office as prescribed by State Law and Municipal Code. Each candidate or his or her designee shall file a Notice of Candidacy and Affidavit, such form is available at www.sos.ga.gov and will also be provided at the qualifying location.

Residents of the City of Kennesaw who are qualified to register to vote, and are not currently registered, or who need to update their voter registration information, may do so through the close of business Tuesday, April 24, 2018. Persons may register to vote online at www.mvp.sos.ga.gov or at any of the designated places for registering Cobb County residents. If you have moved into, out of, or within the city limits of Kennesaw and have not notified the Cobb Board of Elections and Registration, please do so no later than April 24, 2018.

Early In-Person Voting will begin Monday, April 30, 2018 and end on Friday, May 18, 2018. The hours and locations for Early Voting are available on www.CobbElections.org.

Voters who wish to vote by Mail may apply by submitting an application to the Cobb County Elections Office at P.O. Box 649, Marietta, GA 30061, by emailing an application to Absentee@CobbCounty.org or by faxing an application to (770) 528-2458. Applications are available at www.CobbElections.org. Voted ballots must be received by 7:00pm, Tuesday, May 22, 2018.
